



ABOUT THE RACE

The New Balance 5th Avenue Mile is one of 60 adult and youth races produced annually by New York Road Runners, the nonprofit that “runs” New York City. Hosted since 1981, it is the world’s most iconic road mile race, with competitors running down 20 blocks of Manhattan’s Fifth Avenue, which is home to world-class museums and cultural institutions. In its 44th running, 8,500 participants are expected across 30 total heats, including age-group and specialty heats.

TOP STORYLINES

- This year, New York Road Runners teamed up with Broadway Cares/Equity Fights Aids and The Broadway League to host the first ever **Broadway Mile**, an exclusive heat for Broadway performers and theater professionals. **Sierra Boggess, Jordan Fisher, Jeremy Jordan, Jordan Litz, and Patina Miller** are some of the Broadway stars participating, alongside shows including “**The Book of Mormon**,” “**Cabaret**,” and “**Mamma Mia!**” among others.
- Among the 8,500 athletes competing in the New Balance 5th Avenue mile, there will be 11 Olympians, including defending champion **Karissa Schweizer**. **Ajee’ Wilson**, the 2022 World Indoor champion in the 800m, and **Raevyn Rogers**, the 2020 Olympic bronze medalist in the 800m will also be joining the women’s division. **Yared Nuguse**, the 2024 Olympic bronze medalist in the 1500m, alongside **Josh Hoey** and **Hobbs Kessler**, will be leading the men’s field.
- Additional specialty heats include the **Back to School Mile** for kids ages 2 to 18, the **George Sheehan Memorial Mile** for older adults, the **NYRR Road Mile Championship** races, an **NYPD and FDNY** heat for service members, and the **Media Mile** for journalists.
- New York Road Runners offers inclusive and accessible events and programs year-round. The New Balance 5th Avenue Mile offers the perfect entry point for new runners looking to participate in their first race and experienced runners to clock a personal best.

HOW TO WATCH

The 2025 New Balance 5th Avenue Mile will be televised live on WABC-TV, Channel 7 in the New York tri-state area from noon-1 p.m. ET, and available to stream nationwide on ESPN+. New this year, iHeartRadio will provide live race-day radio broadcast on 710 WOR AM and 104.3HD2 in New York, and the iHeartRadio app from noon-1 p.m. ET. For the first time, a live camera feed of the finish line will be available to stream on the NYRR App.

COURSE

The New Balance 5th Avenue Mile course follows Fifth Avenue from East 80th Street to Grand Army Plaza near East 60th Street. The race starts on a slight downhill followed by a slight uphill. The second half features a gentle downhill and a flat stretch to the finish for the final five blocks.

NOTABLE DATES IN EVENT HISTORY

September 26, 1981: The 5th Avenue Mile was inaugurated with a star-studded men's field, featuring Sydney Maree, Steve Scott, John Walker, Steve Cram, Ray Flynn, Mike Boit, Eamonn Coghlan, Tom Byers, and Thomas Wessinghage. Maree of South Africa broke the tape a full two seconds ahead of runner-up Boit of Kenya. Maree's time, 3:47.52, endured as the 5th Avenue Mile event record for 41 years.

September 22, 1990: Former world No. 1 3,000-meter runner Patti Sue Plumer of the United States sat back in fifth place before making a big move and running away to victory in 4:16.68, a course record that stood until 2022. On the men's side, Great Britain's Peter Elliott became 5th Avenue's first three-time champion and threatened the course record with his 3:47.83.

September 24, 2011: American Bernard Lagat finally won the race in his third try—at age 36—with classic sit-and-kick tactics, putting more than a full second on his competitors in the final 100 meters. American Jenny Simpson followed her gold-medal performance in the 2011 World Athletics Championships 1,500 meters by running away from Sally Kipyego of Kenya and Great Britain's Hannah England, who had taken the Worlds silver medal behind Simpson.

September 3, 2016: Jenny Simpson earned her fifth victory on Fifth Avenue to become the outright record-holder for the most wins in event history. She battled Laura Muir of Great Britain down the stretch to win in 4:18.3, her fastest time on the course to date. In the men's race, Eric Jenkins of the United States slipped past Matthew Centrowitz, the Rio 2016 Olympic 1,500-meter gold medalist, in the final meters to break the tape in 3:49.4. Jenkins' time was also the fastest performance by an American in event history.

September 8, 2019: Jenny Simpson won her record-extending eighth title in an event record time of 4:16.1 and Nick Willis won his record-breaking fifth title in a photo-finish in 3:51.7. With 9,274 finishers, it marked the most finishers ever in the history of the event.

September 11, 2022: It was a British sweep as Jake Wightman and Laura Muir took home victories, with Muir breaking the event record in 4:14.8. Coming off his World Championships gold, Wightman won his second consecutive and third overall title. In honor of 9/11, a special Memorial 9/11 heat was held with participants from the Tunnel to Towers Foundation and Answer the Call Foundation, as well as the FDNY and NYPD.

September 8, 2024: Olympic medalist Josh Kerr smashed the 43-year-old men's event record, set by Sydney Maree in 3:47.52, and claimed his second consecutive New Balance 5th Avenue Mile title, clocking 3:44.3. Karissa Schweizer, also an Olympian, conquered the women's race in 4:14.8, tying Laura Muir's event record from 2022.
